 hundred pounds I give and bequeath unto *Thomas* *Evell* of *St. Paul* *Dorset*
County Gentleman *thirteen* pounds *thirteen* shillings I give and bequeath
 unto *William* *Parcy* of *St. Paul* *Dorset* *County* Gentleman the sum of *thirteen*
 pounds *thirteen* shillings and as to all the rest residue and remainder of my
 property estate and effects whatsoever consisting of *book* debts money securities
 for money or stock in any of the public funds or of what nature the same
 may consist including any property over which I may have a power to dispose
 by will or otherwise I give and bequeath the same unto my said brother
Matthew *Mason* and the said *Mary* *Mason* daughter of the said *Matthew* *Mason*
 share and share alike and in the event of the death of either the said *Matthew*
Mason or *Mary* *Mason* the survivor to receive the whole and in the event of both
 dying then the survivor of my said brother *Matthew* *Mason*'s family to take the
 same share and I do hereby nominate and appoint my said brother *Matthew*
Mason and the said *Thomas* *Evell* and *William* *Parcy* to be the Executors of
 this my will and in case of the death of either of them in my lifetime I do hereby
 appoint my said sister *Mary* *Mason* to be Executor and to act with the
 survivor or survivor and I declare this to be my last will and Testament
 being hereby all other and former wills by me at any time heretofore made
 in witness whereof I have to this my last will and Testament and to a duplicate
 thereof caused to be written on three pages of paper set my hand and seal as
 follows to the first two pages I have set my hand and seal and to the third and last
 page I have set my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of April
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine

Proved at London the 14th July 1842 before the worshipful *Jesse* *Abdams* Esq.
 of laws and surrogate by the Oaths of *Matthew* *Mason* the brother and

 the said *Matthew* *Mason* substituted *Thomas* *Evell* for whom admission was granted

 I give to my daughter *Emma* *Mordaunt* my leasehold house & land called *the*
Aboulevard at *Highington* in the parish of *Albion* and all my other moveable
 goods & chattels & Personal Estate whatsoever with the exception of ten pounds
 cash to my sister *Caroline* *Holbert* to my brothers *William* *Edward* & *George*
Holbert & to my sister in law *Jesse* *Maria* *Holbert* requesting cash of *thirteen*
 lay out the sum in a convenient sum of me and also ten pounds cash to every
 servant who has lived with me more than a twelvemonth. Each legacy
 are to be paid free of legacy tax and also I leave to my son *John* *Mordaunt*
Esq my book the way select out of the two hundred books bequeathed to me by my
 beloved brother *Henry* *Dugan* *Holbert* I should leave to him the whole two
 hundred but that I believe many are duplicates of books he already possesses
 and I appoint my son *John* *Mordaunt* *Esq* Executor of this my will to be

of the Charles Henry Martyn Esquire of King Street Greenwiche in the County of Kent Gentleman I desire that all my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses may be paid as soon after my decease as may be due to the rest residue and remainder of my Estate of whatsoever kind it may be I give devise and bequeath to my three brothers John James Martyn Edward Parry Martyn and William Fearnall Martyn in equal proportions share and share alike to be paid to them on their respective attaining the age of twenty one years and in case either of my said brothers should die before attaining the age of twenty one years then it is my Will that the share of the said brother so dying should be divided between the survivor or survivors share and share alike and I hereby appoint my Cousins Richard Smith Esquire of George Street Greenwiche and Henry Turner Esquire of Dartmouth Terrace Dartmouth both in the County of Kent as Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10 day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one - Charles Henry Martyn Esq - Signed sealed published and declared as and for the last Will and Testament of the Testator in the presence of us who at his request and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names - John William King Street Greenwiche - Ann Carttar King Street Greenwiche /s/

John Carttar of King Street in Greenwiche in the County of Kent Esquire Ann Carttar (wife of the said John Carttar) of the same place and Henry Turner Latham of Dartmouth Terrace Dartmouth in the County of Kent Esquire and made Oath and first the said John Carttar for himself made Oath that he is one of the subscribed witnesses to the last Will and Testament hereunto annexed of the said Charles Henry Martyn late of King Street Greenwiche aforesaid Gentleman deceased and with reference to the blank appearing on the said Will for the date of the execution thereof he saith that he attended the said deceased with his fellow Appraiser the said Ann Carttar at the house in King Street aforesaid in which he was then residing for the purpose of witnessing the execution of his Will in the month of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty one though on the said day of the said month the Appraiser cannot now recollect and the Appraiser further saith that from a certain memorandum now in his possession of his having advanced the deceased a sum of money on the fourteenth day of the said month of October to enable him to go to Hastings where he was then at home on account of his health and from the circumstances that the Appraiser will recollect that the said Will was executed by the said Testator a few days only before he so went to Hastings he is enabled to state and saith that the said Will was executed by the said Testator Charles Henry Martyn by his signing his name thereto in the presence of the Appraiser and of his fellow witness the said Ann Carttar both of whom were then present together and who as soon as the said Will was so signed set and subscribed their names as witnesses thereto in the presence of the said Testator and of each other on a day of the said month of
