This will was proved at Westminster the ninth
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred
fifty three before the Judges for probate of Wills and granting of m.
lawfully authorized by Spache of Henry Millward the Sonne and Executor
named in the said will to whom the administration was committed of all
and singular the Goods Chattels and Debts of the said deceased. Hee being
first sworn by Commission well and truly to administer the same.

one thousand six hundred fifty three I Deborah Mordaunt of Ober-
Waldorpe in the parish of Northill in the County of Bedford Widdow
being of perfect Remembrance I praise God but weak in Body doe
make this my last Will and Testament in forme following first I
commend my soule and Body into the hands of Almighty God my Creator
hoping to inherit life everlasting through the merit of my Redeemer
Jesus Christ And for my worldly Estate I do thus dispose of it I give to my
brother Lewis Mordaunt the younger Gent or his Assignes after my decease
to be paid unto him twelve pence of lawfull english money demanding
the same I give to Elizabeth Latham daughter of my sister Elizabeth
Latham fifty pounds of lawfull english money and to Francis Latham
daughter of my said sister Elizabeth twenty pounds of lawfull english
money and to Oliver Latham sonne of my said sister Elizabeth fifty
shillings of lawfull english money to be paid to them upon their severall
demands next after my decease I give to my sister Hannahall Simpson five
pounds of lawfull english money to be paid within six monthes next after
my decease if shee be then living I give to George Simpson sonne of my
sister Hannahall Simpson fifty shillings of lawfull english money to be
paid within six monthes after my decease if hee be then living I give to
Anne Olynth daughter of my sister Hannahall twenty pounds of lawfull
english money to be paid within twelve monthes next after my decease
if shee the said Anne be then living I give to John Simpson five pounds of
lawfull english money (being sonne of my sister Hannahall) to be paid
him within six monthes next after my decease if hee be then living I give to
Elizabeth Simpson daughter of the said Hannahall five pounds of lawfull
english money to be paid within six monthes next after my decease
if shee the said Elizabeth shall be then living I give to William Simpson
sonne of the said Hannahall five pounds of lawfull english money to be
paid within eight monthes next after my decease if hee be then living I
give to my sister Anne Mord five pounds of lawfull english money to
be paid within twelve monthes after my decease if shee be then living
I give to my sister Anne Mord her children twenty shillings a piece.

that she do pay all the Legacies aforesaid and my buriall Expensy I do the Day
and year first above written I the said Deborah Mordaunt do likewise give unto
George Mordaunt my Brother in Law twelve pound to be paid him upon Demand
next after my Decease I give to my sister Margaret Lodding two pound of lawfull
money to be paid upon Demand next after my Decease. I sealed and delivered in
the presence of us as the last Will and Testament of the said Deborah Mordaunt
Walter Chappell Henry Finch.

computation of the Church of England one thousand six hundred fifty
three I John Mordaunt of Lingwood in the County of Norfolk husbandman
being weak and sick in body but of good and perfect Remembrance
shalt be therefore given unto Almighty God do make and ordain this my
last Will and Testament in manner and forme following first and before all things
I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my heavenly Father and
Creator and to Jesus Christ my Saviour and Redeemer by whose Meritt
death and passion I trust assuredly to have pardon and Remission of my
sinnes and to be made partaker of everlasting joy and happiness and after
this life ended in the Kingdom of heaven shall my body be committed to the Earth
from whence it came to be buried in decent and Christian buriall at the
direction of my Exectrix hereafter named I do give and bequeath unto
Margery my wellbelovd Wife my house and Land therunto belonging lying
and being in Lingwood aforesaid for and during the term of her naturall
life which I had by assignement of a Lease for five hundred years of Roger
Rogbold of Lingwood aforesaid gentleman and after the Decease of her the
said Margery my Wife thou I will devise and bequeath the aforesaid
premises with the Appurtenances therunto belonging unto him the said Roger
Rogbold his heirs and assigns during the term of the said Lease of five
hundred years then to come and unexpired upon condition following and no
other wise that is to say that he the said Roger Rogbold his heirs or
Administrators shall pay or cause to be payed unto John my Sonne his heirs
Exectrix and Administrators the sum of twenty and five pound of lawfull
english money within one year next after the Decease of me and Margery
