

FRANK MORDAUNT ARRESTED.

Hearing angry voices at Twelfth-street and Third-avenue, about 7:30 o'clock Tuesday night, Policeman Keyes went to the spot and found a man and woman quarreling. The woman told the policeman to arrest the man, saying that he had assaulted her. The officer did so, and conducted him to the Fifth-street station, where he gave his name as Frank Mordaunt, the actor, of No. 106 East Fourteenth-street. The woman was his divorced wife, who still calls herself Mrs. Fanny Mordaunt, of the Broadway Hotel. Mr. Mordaunt was the first prisoner arraigned in the Essex Market Court yesterday. Mrs. Mordaunt did not appear, and he was discharged. The clerk said that a woman had called early in the morning and told him that she did not want to prosecute the prisoner.
