have in executing the Trusts hereby reposed in him the sum of ten pounds of like lawfull money I have given to the said Ralph Dabsterfoild as a small acknowledgement for the trouble which he may have in atting as one of the Executors of this my will one Guinea and I give to my friend and Acquaintance Mr. William Dallingor one Guinea and subject to the payment of my debts Legacies and Honorall expences) I give and bequeath all my plate Ready moneys debts and Residue of my Goods Chattells and personall Estate whatsoever not herein before otherwise devised given or disposed of unto my said Wife Merry Waller her Executors and administrators for her and their own use and benefitt and I hereby revoke and make void all former Wills by me made and doe constitute and appoint my said nephew William Morrison and the said Ralph Dabsterfoild Executors of this my last will and Testament in Witnesse whereof I the said George Morrison to this my last will and Testament contained in six sheets of paper (written with my own hand) have set my hand and seal as followeth (viz) my hand at or near the bottom of all the five first sheets of the said six sheets and my hand and seal upon the last sheet of the said six sheets this eighth day of August in the year of our Lord 1722 and in the ninth year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord George by the Grace of God King of Great Brittain &c George Morrison signed sealed published and declared by the above named George Morrison the Testator as and to be his last will and Testament in the presence of us who at his request and in his presence have subscribed our names as Witnesses therunto Jobt Southam Peter Caylor a Caylor in Craone Court Chancery Lane Cho: Rodham

 Wrotham I also nominate constitute and appoint full and sole  
 Executor of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby revoke
