 my Parents twenty Pounds Sterling per annum and  
 the remaining to be equally divided amongst my sisters  
 only to observe that it is my Will and desire that my  
 Brother Aziel and Sister Janet receive as much  
 as all as the rest it appears by my Letter Book and  
 Memorandum Books of the Madeira Wine & consigned  
 to George Malcolme Esquire from Kingston and also  
 what money is due to me in the Bay of Honduras  
 in my chest containing Cloths Water &c. valued at one  
 hundred Pounds Sterling & Cash in the said Chest or  
 about fifteen Pounds Samaira Currency the Rent  
 that is in my Chest to be given to Miss Swamala  
 Campbell formerly at Mr. Aziel's Care in Kingston
